ICU Monitors – Lafayette General Medical Center

When the Foundation reached out to clinical areas to assess their needs, Jonathon Koob, MHA,BSN,RN,CCRN-K, director of critical care services spoke up."Thinking it was a long shot, I informed them that the transport monitors needed to be replaced. The monitors were considered capital purchases, and we were tight on capital at the time."

The Foundation agreed to purchase a new monitor. It cut down on the size and weight of the transport monitor by more than half.

"With this monitor we are able to monitor all of the same vital signs and hemodynamic parameters (cardiac measurements) on our most critical patients while moving them to surgery or other diagnostic exams," said Koob.

This has improved the quality of monitoring, ensuring appropriate assessment and early recognition of changes in patient condition. Prior to this, the monitors we had provided unreliable readings and intermittent images.
